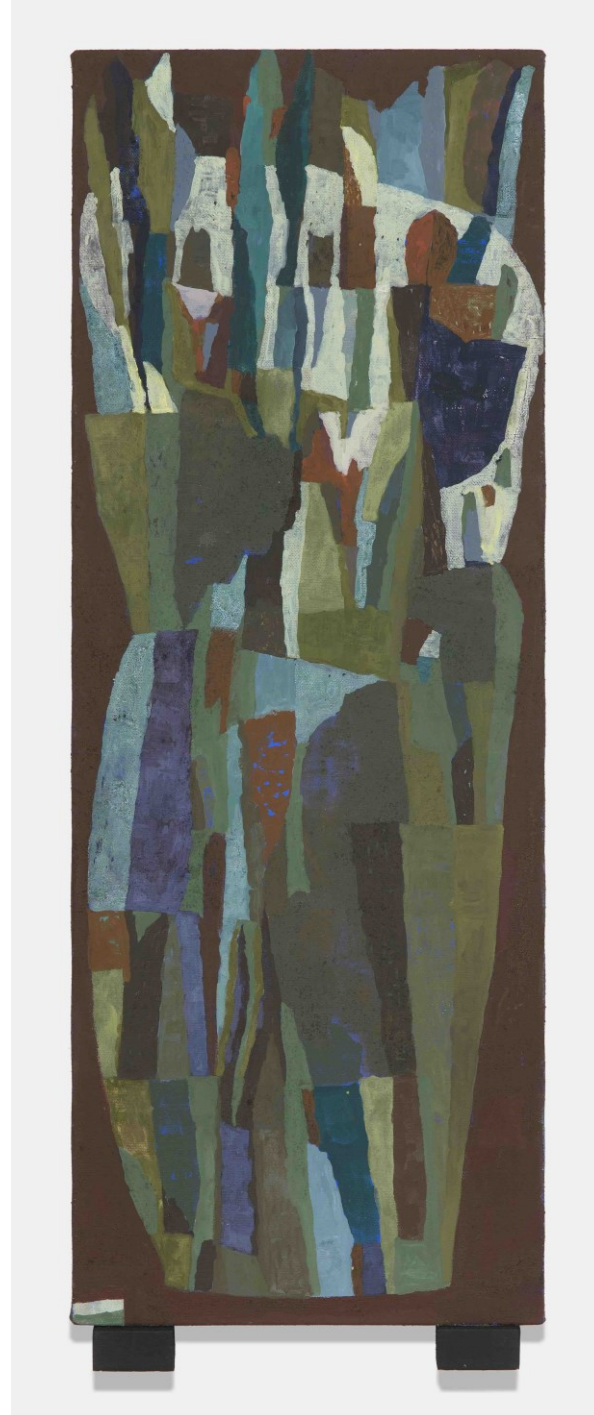

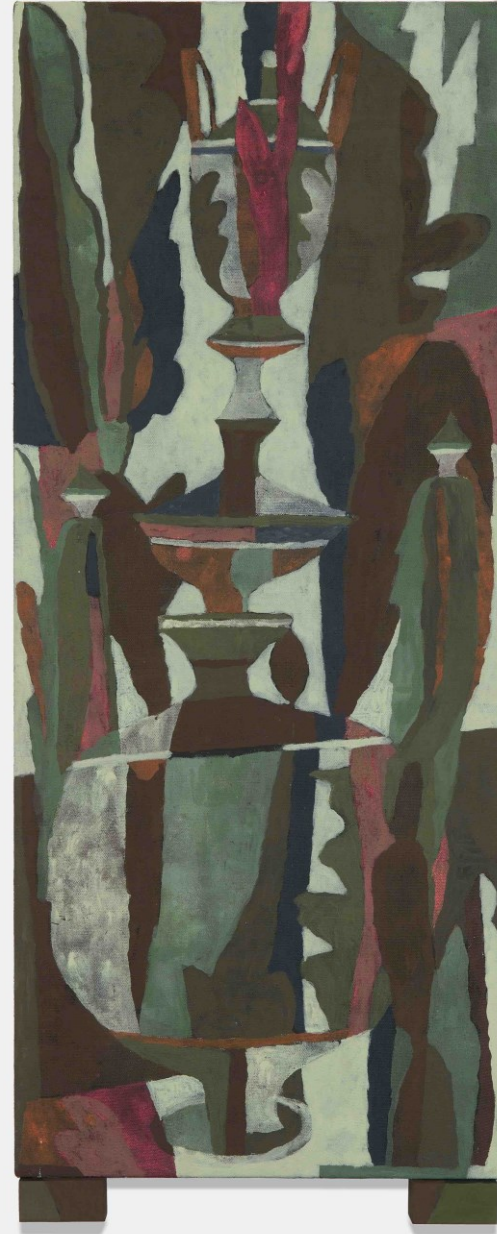

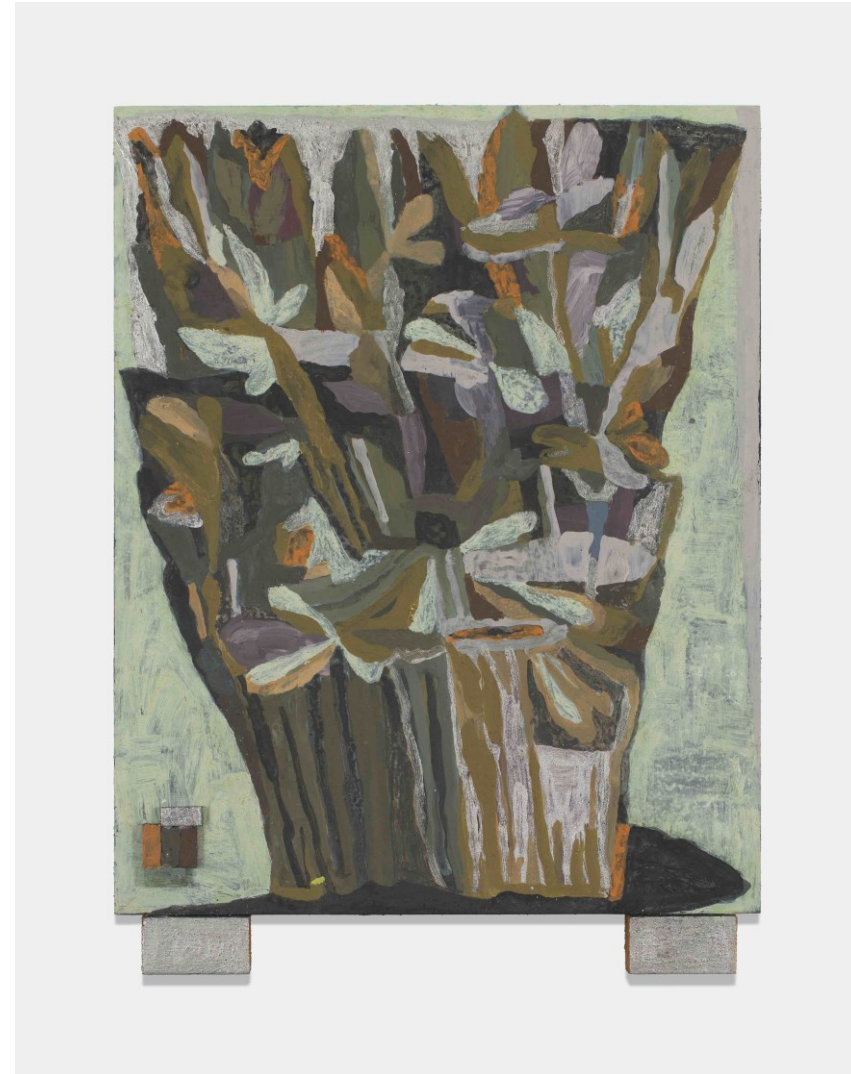

Ruth Waller was born in Sydney in 1955. She graduated from the Alexander Mackie School of Art in 1978 and in 2000 completed a Masters by Research in Art Theory at the ANU School of Art. She has lectured in art since 1979 in Sydney at TAFE, Sydney University and East Technical College. From 1990 she lectured fulltime in Painting at the ANU School of Art. From 2006 to 2018 she was Associate Professor, Head of Painting, ANU School of Art & Design and currently she is an Honorary Associate Professor.

Over the past thirty years she has exhibited widely throughout Australia in solo and group shows. Her work is held in the National Gallery of Australia, the National Gallery of Victoria, the Art Gallery of NSW and the Art Gallery of Queensland and Artbank, as well as in numerous Regional Gallery collections, including those of the Wollongong City Gallery, the New England Regional Art Museum, the Ballarat City Gallery, the Warnambool Gallery, the Manly Art Gallery & Museum, the Maitland Regional Gallery, the Lake Macquarie Regional Gallery, the Gold Coast Regional Art Gallery and the Canberra Museum & Gallery; University and private collections.

She has received Australia Council awards for residencies in Italy, Spain and Finland, and an FRGS Grant to travel to Europe to study late Flemish altarpieces.
